ACTIVITY REPORT OF CACHAR ZONE

During the tenure of almost 1 year 7 executive meetings of the Cachar Zone including 2 online extended meetings were held with the Unit President and Secretary of our 10 units. The first executive meeting was held on 11 January 2022 where we chalked out the annual plan. In order to meet our goals we took up different activity throughout the year. One of the prime objectives was the reformation of examinations of Assam University. In this regard we submitted a memorandum to the vice chancellor, AUS on 12 April, 2022 comprising all the relevant issues regarding reformation of examinations. We had several discussions with the VC as well as CoE in order to resolve the pertinent issues concerning examinations and evaluations such as perennial delay in declaration of result, revise remuneration structure for the evaluation zones, implementation of NEP 2020 etc.

The most dominant event of this year was the Cachar College episode. All are aware of the incident happened in Cachar College involving the whimsical, arrogant Principal. But as an organization we have learnt a lot from it. As an academic non-political organization our prime focus is to ensure suitable academic atmosphere and safeguard the interests of the teachers. We proved that to achieve and restore these we can go into any extent. Once again, we showed the strength of the unity, determination to fight against all odds for justice.

Various prominent issues dominated this tenure. The issue of promotion and fixation was one of those. Due to several reasons only one list of promotion appeared during this year. But we have a long wait for the fixation. The issue was raised and discussed in the CEC meetings also and due to persistent effort of our central leadership we got an online portal for this purpose which will be effective within a month. The NPS issue was also a prominent one and ACTA leadership adopted a concrete view towards with the cooperation of All Assam Govt. NPS Employees Association. The

fight for the OPS is justified will be a long one and we have to show our strength by joining hands with AAGNPSEA in order to achieve OPS. We are very much grateful to our central leadership.

As our strength is further increased after joining of 4 newly provincialized colleges of Cachar Zone jurisdiction, so increased our responsibilities. The newly added member colleges have different set of problems and already some of them were discussed in the earlier CEC meetings. But the issues pertaining to these colleges need to be addressed on an urgent basis and the CEC will be requested to the needful. The issue of 8000 fixed pay teachers also was an important matter before us. We have a good number of members who had been suffering due to this. After fighting against all odds ultimately this CEC could achieve success in this matter. We could see the last list of such teachers who were promoted in the last week. I express my gratitude to the central leadership on behalf our teachers for this achievement.

As an academic organization ACTA always endeavor to involve itself in academic activity. We organized a one-day State level workshop on the Accreditation framework of NAAC on 22 March 2022 in Radha Madhab College where Prof. Niranjana Roy of AUS and Dr. Anupam Dutta, Finance Secretary, ACTA acted as resource persons. The workshop was attended by representatives from different colleges of Cachar Zone. We chalked out an activity map on the same day highlighting the problems faced by newly provincialized colleges regarding NAAC Accreditation and tried our best to implement it.

The NEP-2020 will perhaps be the most prominent topic in the coming days. Already Govt. of Assam as well as AUS declared that the NEP-2020 will be implemented from the next academic session i.e., 2023-24. Keeping in mind the available resources and infrastructure we have to implement the NEP. The Govt. of Assam sought feedback on their draft NEP framework and we in ACTA suggested various modifications regarding it. In the coming days it will be a big challenge for us to implement and get the benefit out of it.

The Annual Zonal Conference of Cachar Zone was held in Cachar College on 12 December 2022. Sri Himangshu Maral, President, ACTA graced the occasion as the Chief Guest. A new Executive Committee was elected in that meeting as follows-

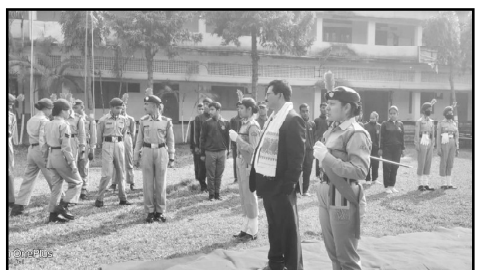
